The purpose of UWF is to unite graduates of regionally accredited educational institutions in order to promote equity, education, intellectual growth, individual worth, and development of opportunities for women and girls in the Flagler County area. UWF promotes positive societal change in the community; participates in the development and promotion of policies and programs through study, action, and public policy advocacy in areas related to its purpose, including community, cultural interests, and the maintenance of high standards in education.

The UWF holds general meetings monthly from September through May, publishes a newsletter, *The WAVE*, and holds fundraising events to support its scholarship funds.

Membership is open to all women with a 4-year college degree or higher.
